



THE MATERNELLE RULES

The purpose of this document is to inform the parents of the policies and procedures of the maternelle. Every student registered at the maternelle and their families are expected to respect these rules and policies.

PART 1: COMPULSORY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

A regular attendance is compulsory.

The pupils shall attend all the classes mentioned in their timetable.

Every pupil should wear appropriate footwear for the practice of sports.

Any absence must be justified with a written note from the parents or the legal responsible with a medical certificate in case the student is absent for more than two days.

A student who is absent for more than fifteen consecutive days without justification will face expulsion.

PART 2: HOURS AND MOVEMENTS

There are 24 hours of class in a week organised in seven half-days.

A day at school goes as follow:

- In the morning from 7:50am to 11:50am
- In the afternoon from 1.30pm to 3.30pm

Amharic class

The Amharic classes are compulsory and will take place in the weekly timetable.

The gates open as follow:

- **Morning-** **In:** gates open at 7:20am
gates close at 8:00am
Out: gates open at 11:40am
gates close at 12:10pm
- **Afternoon -** **In:** gates open at 1:20pm
gates close at 1:30pm
Out: gates open at 3:20pm
gates close at 4:10pm
gates open at 5:00pm
gates close at 5:20pm

Students Entrance:

The pupils come in and out exclusively from the north maternelle gate. It is strictly forbidden to use the others gates to either enter or exit (except for the school's staff).

The children must be handed over by their parents or a parent-approved person to the staff of the school or the teacher and will have to show the school's ID to take their children to their classrooms in the morning.

The pupils exit:

At 11:40am and 3:20pm, the adults must show the school's ID to be able to pick up the children when the school is finished or during class hours. The children are not allowed to leave the school alone. In case you are not able to pick up your child please immediately contact the office: **01.11.55.21.30 or 09.30.10.55.84**

At 12:10pm, the children who were not picked up will be placed under the surveillance of the school staff.

After 4:10pm, the children will be waiting at the child care, the parents will have to pay for the child care service at the cashier's office. After 4:20pm the parents will have to wait 5:00pm to pick up their children.

After 5:20pm, the children waiting at the door will be taken to the primary school library until they are picked up.

At 7:00pm, the children will be kept in the school premises under the responsibility of the guards on Churchill road until their parents pick them up, even after the school has closed. The parents will be charged by the hours.

"Guest" pupils: when a child is invited by a classmate at lunch time or 4:00pm the parents must provide a written approval for any adult or student they are allowing to pick up their child.

The children will be picked up by their parents as soon as their class ends.

In case of repeated negligence to pick up their children at fixed hours, temporary or definitive exclusion will be considered.

During lunch recess, the school will not be responsible for the children who are not in the school premises. Only the school staff is allowed to be in the school premises (lunch starts at 11:50am).

Arriving late:

Arriving late seriously disrupts the class and will be sanctioned if repeated. The pupils who arrive late must be accompanied by their parents to the maternelle office.

Fetching a pupil during school time:

The parents who decide to take their children out during class or recess must fill in the form at the security post and write a note to the teacher or the primary school office.

Recess:

When the bell rings for the children to go back to their classes, the children will quickly stand in line, go to their classroom, without running and in silence under the supervision of their teacher.

Students are not permitted in classrooms unsupervised during recess or class hours.

PART 3: CHILDCARE SERVICE

A **childcare service** is available from 4:00pm to 5:00pm. The parents who wish to leave their children at the childcare must buy a card at the cashier's office.

PART 4: LIFE AT SCHOOL

The students and their family must forbid themselves any behaviour, gesture or words offending the teacher or any other school staff or classmate and their family.

Brutality, biting, throwing stones, pushing one another in the staircase, violent games are forbidden. The pupils must not bring any object that could harm them or their classmates (weapon, knife, slingshot, bottles, gun, sharp scissors, lollipops, chewing gum...) or bring hazardous products.

Cell phones and electronic devices are forbidden.

The children's clothes must be identified with their names.

The school will not be liable for theft within the premises of the school; nevertheless the school will not be indifferent to the problem. Any found object or clothing item must be brought in. The pupils will be held responsible for any voluntary damage of the material and furniture. They will be sanctioned for it. The family will be charged for the repair of the caused damage.

The "cahier de vie" must be covered with the name and the grade of the child clearly written. The pupils must take good care of it. Any book or DVD borrowed, lost or damaged will have to be replaced or reimbursed by the family.

The teacher will decide on how to celebrate the children's birthdays. However, cakes, gifts, drinks coming for the outside are not accepted.

PART5:THE WORK OF THE STUDENT AND INFORMATION TO THE FAMILIES.

Each semester when meeting with the teacher, the family will be able to see their children's report book and the teacher's comments. This report book must be signed during the meeting with the teacher.

The director and the teachers are at the parent's disposal for any information about their child's schooling. Parents are encouraged to meet with the teachers especially when the child is encountering difficulties at school.

The teachers should not be disturbed during class. The parents can ask for an appointment through the correspondence book or meet with the teachers after their class hours.

There will be parents/ teachers meetings organised each beginning of year and end of semester. It is the parents' duty to participate to those meetings.

There is an information board at the school's entrance for the families to read any information concerning the life of their children at school. The families will also be informed through internet.

PART6:HYGIENE, HEALTH AND SECURITY

Hygiene and health

The children coming to school must not show signs of illness and be potty trained.

A child who gets dirty too often will not be accepted at school and could face expulsion if the problem persists.

A child who gets ill or injured will be taken to the infirmary. The nurses will take the right action but if necessary the family will be notified. The family must inform the school in case they change phone number or address.

A sick child must be kept at home.

A child who is excluded from school will have to come to school with a medical certificate attesting to the complete recovery.

If a child is found with lice, the parents should let the school know and proceed with treatment.

A child with a cast must come to school with a medical certificate and an authorization from the parents disclaiming the school from any liability in case of accident.

It is forbidden for a child to carry medicine. If the child is under medical treatment, the parents will have to bring a doctor's prescription and the child must come to the infirmary to take his/her medication under the supervision of the nurse.

In case of chronic disease (asthma, heart condition, allergy, epilepsy...) the parents should inform the school in order to fill in an Emergency medical information form.

Security

Security exercises are carried out in compliance with the applicable regulation. In case of fire, earthquake or any other situation that will require to evacuate the place, the students will follow under the supervision of the teacher the security rules that hang on the classrooms walls. The rules will be explained at the beginning of the school year and repeated every trimester.

Moving around the school

The street that gives access to the north gate is a one-way street. The traffic sign forbids to U-turn and come out on Churchill road. The parents are expected to park their cars properly and respect the rules of the road regulations to secure the children’s safety.

PART 7: SCHOOL INSURANCE

When you register at school you also subscribe to an individual insurance, to which you can add a family insurance.
